The Public Employees' Benefits Program (PEBP) is partnering with **HSA Bank** as the new Health Savings Account (HSA) and Health Reimbursement Arrangement (HRA) administrator beginning July 1, 2022. As a HealthSCOPE accountholder, we will have a series of webinars to learn about HSA Bank, important dates and what to expect in the coming weeks. The webinars will demonstrate how easy it is to move your existing HSA from HealthSCOPE to HSA Bank. **If you have a Health Reimbursement Arrangement (HRA) no action is required on your part.** If you have HRA funds in your account on June 30th, your balance will transfer automatically from Healthscope to HSA Bank.

Why should I transfer my HSA from HealthSCOPE to HSA Bank?

- **Avoids Fees & More Ease of Use** –HealthSCOPE will charge you a monthly administrative fee of \$2.50/month if you do not transfer your account to HSA Bank by July 31, 2022. In addition, moving your account will increase ease of use by having one card, one client assistance line and one portal for account management.
