





Older Adults Can Receive Additional Dose of COVID-19 Vaccine

The CDC has approved the recommendation for an additional dose of any of the 2023-2024 COVID-19 vaccines (Pfizer, Moderna, Novavax) to <u>all</u>

<u>people aged 65+ at</u> <u>least 4 months after</u> their last dose.

Most COVID-19 deaths and hospitalizations last

year were among people 65 years and older. An additional vaccine dose can provide added protection that may have decreased over time for those at highest risk.
