For PEBP participants enrolled in the CDHP, LD, and EPO plans

Photo ID, Insurance Card and Consent Form REQUIRED

No out-of-pocket costs for eligible participants and their covered dependents.

Flu: Flu shots are available to members of all ages and covered dependent children 6 months and older with a parent present.

COVID-19: The <u>COVID-19 vaccine</u> is available for covered participants 12 years and older. You cannot have had another booster within the last four months to receive another dose.

RSV: Respiratory syncytial virus (RSV) is a common respiratory virus that usually causes mild, cold-like symptoms. Most people recover in a week or two, but RSV can be serious. Infants and older adults are more likely to develop severe RSV and need hospitalization. <u>Vaccines are available to protect older adults</u> aged 60 and older from severe RSV.

<u>Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis)</u>: Diphtheria and pertussis spread from person to person, and tetanus enters the body through cuts or wounds. The <u>CDC recommends Tdap vaccination</u> every 10 years for covered participants 7 years and older.

<u>Hepatitis B</u>: The <u>CDC recommends the hepatitis B vaccine</u> for all age groups. Hepatitis B is a serious disease caused by a virus (HBV) that attacks the liver. The virus can cause lifelong infection, cirrhosis and cancer of the liver, liver failure and death.

Pneumonia: The CDC recommends pneumococcal vaccination for all children younger than 2 years old and all adults 65 years or older. You must meet the age requirements to be considered preventive and covered at \$0 copay. Standard copayment will apply if filled outside the specified age limits.

<u>Shingles:</u> The <u>CDC recommends two doses of recombinant zoster vaccine (Shingrix)</u> to prevent shingles and related complications in adults 50 years and older. You must meet the age requirements to be considered preventive and covered at \$0 copay. Standard copayment will apply if filled outside the specified age limits.



Did you know?

The Center for Disease Control and Prevention provides recommendations for vaccines and immunizations for children (birth to 18 years), adults (19 and older), pregnant women and travelers. Visit the CDC's Vaccine & Immunization schedules and recommendations here.

COVID-19 booster shots must be administered at least four months after your last booster. The **shingles vaccination** must be taken in two doses, two to six months apart. For the second dose, schedule an appointment at a participating in-network pharmacy, or schedule an appointment with your primary care provider (PCP). Visit PEBP's Find a Provider page to **find in-network pharmacies and providers** under your health insurance plan at Find a Provider (nv.gov).

Administrative leave is authorized per NAC 284.589.6(b) for **active employees** attending a PEBP coordinated event. PEBP recommends employees work with their supervisor to request approval to attend a clinic.
